The Southern New Hampshire Resource Conservation and Development (SoNH RC&D) Area Council serves the six-county area of Merrimack, Cheshire, Sullivan, Hillsborough, Strafford and Rockingham.

It is registered as a 501 (c) (3) Non-profit and can serve as a receiver of monies such as donations and grants for projects in this area.

Its role is as a catalyst and a facilitator to bring together people and resources. SoNH RC&D can also serve as a liaison with other USDA Programs.
