
## New Hampshire School Administrators Association

As part of our mission, NHSAA regularly provides highly specialized services directly to individual public school districts in NH by completing an independent investigation and analysis of a school district's educational programs, a facility needs assessment, and developing educational specifications and facility options for a school district's student population. We often develop a prioritized listing of recommendations that effectively and efficiently utilize existing facilities, modify or renovate existing schools, and project the need for new facilities for a district's consideration. In addition, we may develop a description of the site needs necessary to accommodate the required or desired school program.

The following chart highlights a few of the studies that NHSAA has completed over the past few years and provides examples of NHSAA's specialized services, which may include, but are not limited to an independent demographic assessment of a school district's population and the creation of a K-12 student enrollment forecast.
